
Dr. Paul Underberg, the grandson of the Underberg founder, was a cosmopolitan and passionate explorer of foreign cultures.

Preparation: Put 2-3 ice cubes into a highball glass, fill it up half-way with tonic. Slowly pour 4 cl Brasilberg in the glass so that Brasilberg and tonic don't mix. Serve with a lime, herbs and a stirrer. Stir it shortly before drinking!
